Special Conditions

PLEASE READ the latest BRCA "Getting Back on Track". In addition to this document Stafford RCMCC will keep some of its current restrictions, however this will be reviewed when required.

Please note: The Club will continue its online booking system for all its events. You will not be able to book in or pay on the day.

Indoor Venue:

We are continuing our Covid-19 conditions at our indoor venue for the safety of you and other people attending an event.

PPE: (Personal Protective Equipment)

The club will not supply any of the following, therefore if you wish to race then you **MUST** supply your own PPE. You will need:

- *Your Own Hi-Viz Waistcoat for Marshalling.
- *Your own pair of Gloves for Marshalling. Not latex disposable type, but ones suitable for working in.
- *Your own Face Mask. Face Mask **MUST** be worn correctly (it **MUST** cover your mouth and nose to be acceptable.! PLEASE NOTE: A SHIELD is **NOT** acceptable. (Exceptions see below)
- *Your Own Bottle of Hand Sanitiser with a minimum of 70% of alcohol contents.

For your **ADDED** safety, the venues have sanitizer, and the club has a none contact forehead temperature monitor to check people's temperature. If your temperature is raised, you may be asked to leave the venue.

Face Masks

Face masks must be worn by all participants at **ALL** times with the exception when eating or drinking when participants may temporarily remove their mask.

Please wait until drivers from the previous race have cleared the individual rostrum stands. Go to your correct rostrum stand, number one is nearest Race control followed by number two and so on (If you have a car problem whilst the race is running, you **MUST NOT** leave your rostrum stand until the race has finished).

Outdoor Venue:

At our outdoor venue we will adhere to the latest BRCA guidelines. However as mentioned in the document "Getting Back on Track" dated 16th July 2021 not all the clubs' restrictions will be lifted. The main points are:

- *As with our indoor venue you will still need to provide your own PPE
- *We will still keep our one-way system for entering and leaving the track area
- *We will still keep the 1meter + whilst waiting to race and on the rostrum (i.e. you must keep to social distancing and wear a mask.)
- * You must also wear a mask when in either cabin or in a queue (i.e. when queueing at the food wagon)
- * We will remove the requirement to wear a mask at other times but we still strongly encourage you to adhere to the BRCA guidelines.

Please wait until drivers have cleared from Rostrum from previous race. Entry to Rostrum is via the Steps nearest Race Control these are one-way Entry Only; You MUST stand on foot markings on Rostrum Floor. If you have a car problem whilst the race is running you MUST NOT leave the rostrum, just take a step back so you don't obstruct anyone's view. At the end of your race drive your car to your Marshal Point. Leave the Rostrum exit via the steps furthest from Race Control in order, do not pass behind people which will mean reducing your social distancing then go straight to your car at your Marshal point, DON'T GO TO YOUR PITS UNTIL YOU HAVE FINISHED MARSHALLING. After Marshalling return to your Pitting area

Please be aware that you will still need to wear a pair of work gloves whilst marshalling. Also, it is a BRCA requirement that you wear Hi-Vis whilst marshalling.

Please work with us on the above, until we get used to this "NEW NORMAL" We are trying to protect everyone, therefore, should anyone blatantly abuse these special conditions they could be asked to leave the site, without refund, and their details may be passed to the BRCA who in turn could revoke their licence.
