



LMH (Le Mans Hypercar) at Stafford Outdoor Raceway is a class for 2026, designed for racers who want to participate using their existing 4WD Touring car chassis and replacing just the motor for the more controllable 21.5t and fitting a LMH body, still using their existing electrics i.e. ESC (If fixed Timing, Receiver & Servo). The specs are straight forward as you will see below, the idea is that this is a great looking class without the “Bash n Crash” of the 17.5 Touring class.

Please NO one-cans unless stickered like an LMH, and no flames, fades, etc. Make it look like a LMH car.



- **Motor:** – Any 21.5t (or higher) Stock (No Timing adjustment) Brushless Motor as listed on the approved BRCA EB List
- **ESC:** – Any ZERO-timing (Blinky) ESC from the approved BRCA EB
- **Tyre's:** – Any commercially available rubber TC tyre is allowed. (No Foam)
- **Weight:** – 1300g Minimum as per BRCA Rules
- **Width:** – 170-190mm (not including shell)
- **Bodies:** – any BRCA currently listed LMH Class Body.
- **Style:** We encourage you to make your body look like a real LMH (See **Paint** Below)
- **Paint:** Please NO one-cans unless stickered like an LMH, and no flames, fades, etc.
- **No** Hi-performance shells i.e. no **jellymolds!!!**
